

Sermon based Bible Study

**Based on Sermon (Isaiah 40:27-31) preached on 2 Oct 2022 @ Agape Methodist Church*

How to use this Bible Study:

1. Study can be used for personal devotion or DG setting.
2. Discussion questions are based on sermon preached on 2 Oct 2022 at Agape Methodist Church.
3. Where necessary, participants can refer to the recorded sermon (at AgMC's website) for help with the questions.
4. Remember to leave enough time for the word of God to sink deep into our heart and ask God to help us do His will.

READ: Sermon text (Isaiah 40:27-31)

RELATE:

1. Why is it important to know and be convicted about the truth that God is "all-knowing"?
2. Was there a time in your life where you doubted that God is near and is able to help you? What did you do?
3. Why do you think sometimes God choose not to intervene in a time where everyone thinks that God should e.g. When Putin invaded Ukraine? When Hitler persecuted the Jews?
4. How far can you really accept that when God does not act, it is for His timing and will?

5. When you face a difficult situation or a choice to make, how can you actively wait upon the Lord and draw strength from Him?

REST

As you close the study, give yourself to prayer or even close in a time of worship. The recommended song is “Wait for the Lord” by Taize.
